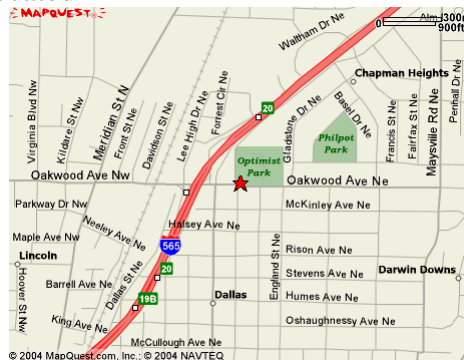
Please join us in welcoming two new members for January 2006.
