Holy crap, he's using the legendary 1970 AAR 'Cuda as a foundation for his creation. Body mods include a retro style cuda grille and tail panel, shaker hood, and a very aggressive front spoiler. Reinforcing the theme, the sides of the Hemi Orange Super 'Cuda are boldly accented with satin-black strobe stripes. Inside the cockpit features a Hurst Shifter, a Katzkin "Barracuda" custom leather interior with a Hemi Orange perforated inserts and Super 'Cuda monogrammed carpet mats. The engine is a ground-pounding Hemi fitted with a Kenne Bell blower (up to 900 hp) and of course there's the best of the best suspension upgrades for firm launches and hard cornering. Man-oh-man I want that car!
